	2. Open Women's Team Event (Maximum Number of Players per team - 06) Each tie is composed of two Women's Singles and one Women's Doubles.
	3. Over 45 Men's Team Event (Maximum Number of Players per team - 06) Each tie is composed of one Men's Singles and two Men's Doubles.
	4. Open Mixed Team Event (Maximum Number of Players per team - 06) Each tie is composed of one Men's Single, One Women's Single & Mixed Double.
	Each player is eligible to play one single match and one double match at a tie at any event.
	University Student
	Mixed Team Event (Maximum Number of Players per team - 06) Each tie is composed of one Men's Single, one Women's Single, one Men's double, one Women's double & Mixed Double.
	Each player is eligible to play any two matches at a tie.
Entries	Age will be calculated as at 01 st January 2023 for Over 45 Events. i.e. Players should born before 01 st January 1978 will eligible to participate in Over 45 event.
	All Players must enter the Date of Birth and all relevant details required in the Entry Form when submitting the entry and shall produce the NIC, Passport or Birth Certificate when requested by the Referee / Tournament Committee.
	Each University are eligible to enter maximum of two teams for each event. The Tournament Committee shall cancel an event in the Tournament if there are less than four (4) entries.
	Teams are advised to submit entries ONLINE to the email ID anusha@ped.cmb.ac.lk or hand over at Department of Physical Education office, University of Colombo.

Eligibility	Only permanent Staff members of invited Universities and Institutions are eligible to take part in university staff events. Please bring your staff identity card or a relevant document to prove your eligibility. Full time internal registered undergraduates of invited Universities and Institutions are eligible to take part in university student event. Please bring your student identity card or a relevant document to prove your eligibility.
Format of Play	All team events will be played in two stages: a round-robin group stage followed by a knockout stage. A tie shall be stopped when the tie is decided. All matches will be played using the best of 3 games and 21 rally points scoring system. The
	tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton, and BWF Competition Regulations.
Rankings in the event:	At the round-robin group stage of the team events, the teams ranked 1 st and 2 nd in each group will be qualified to knockout stage. Rankings at the round-robin group stage will be determined by the number of ties won. If two teams equal at any ranking stage, the winner of their tie will be ranked higher. If three or more teams have won the same number of ties, their rankings will be determined by the quotient between total matches won and total matches lost, with
	 greater quotient ranked higher. If three or more teams have won the same number of ties and quotient between total matches won and total matches lost, their rankings will be determined by the quotient between total games won and total games lost, with greater quotient ranked higher. If three or more teams have won the same number of ties, quotient between total matches won and total matches lost and quotient between total games won and total games lost their rankings will be determined by the quotient between total points won and total points lost, with greater quotient ranked higher. If three or more teams are still equal, then ranking will be established by drawing lots
	If a team is unable to complete a match in a tie (e.g. retiring or conceding a match due to illness, injury or other unavoidable hindrance), the result of that match shall count as if completed without the conceding side scoring another point.
Certificates & Medals	Certificates & Medals will be awarded to all Winners & Runners-Up, and Certificates will be awarded to Semi-Finalists of the tournament.
	Trophy will be awarded to champion teams of all categories. Award Presentation: During the Award Ceremony, players should wear tracksuits/ sportswear. (No sandals or slippers permitted)
Shuttles	Naylon shuttlecocks (Yonex Mavis 600) shall be used for all university staff events. Feather Shuttlecocks shall be used for university student event.
Competition Rules & Regulation	Relevant Badminton World Federation Regulations as adapted by SLB, shall be applicable to this competition.
Compliance with SLB Regulations	In submitting the entry the Competitor concerned accepts the SLB regulations, Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Processes, which shall be final and binding.
